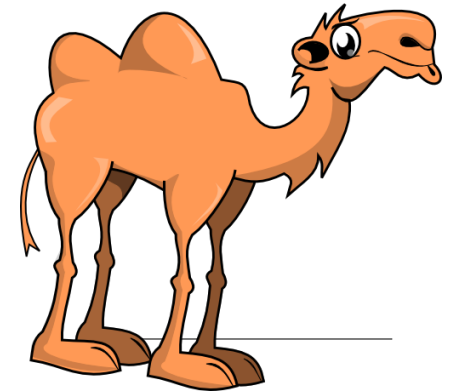
- Loose leaf paper—college ruled

Consequences

1. **Time Out** is used to help you have time to think about how you did not meet one or more of the expectations above. You should use this time to figure out what you could have done differently in order to be a good disciple for Christ.
2. **Loss of Activity Privilege.** Participating in activities is a privilege that is provided to you by your leader, and with it comes some responsibilities on your part. Whether you lose the privilege to participate in an activity is totally up to you because you are the one that chose the behavior. Can you imagine how sad Jesus must be to see that you were not a good example for others? Jesus forgives us and we forgive each other when we fall short of what we should do. You should forgive yourself and try really hard not to lose anymore privileges. I know you can do it. Ask Jesus to help you do better next time.
3. **Meeting with Parents** is sometimes necessary to assist you in becoming a better example for others. Most of the time your leader will be able to help you figure out what Jesus would have you do, but time Out and Loss of Activity Privilege will be tries before Meeting with Parents. All meetings with parents will be conducted by the current parent/child liaison for Mount Carmel United Methodist Church.



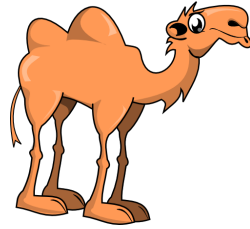

Welcome to Carmel Kids Academy!

Mt. Carmel UMC is a free after school enrichment program for elementary kids (K-5th grade) on Wednesdays during the school year beginning August 2017 and ending in June 2018. Kids will be welcomed by caring adults from 2:30pm until 6:00pm. We will follow the school calendar which includes early release days. Please note: we will not be open if the school is closed for holidays, work days or inclement weather. Activities will include snacks, recreation time, reading and homework assistance, and being a part of a community music-arts-drama club from 4:30-5:00pm. The program is free but spaces are limited to 24 kids. We have staff and volunteers who are trained to help your child with homework and reading skills. All of our CKA staff and volunteers comply with our Safe Sanctuary Policy. Parents or guardians will need to arrange transportation to our facility at 4265 Ebert Road in Winston-Salem. If your child attends Kimmel Farm Elementary School, you can fill out a bus change stop form for Wednesdays only. We have an arrangement with this school to drop off kids after school on the Farris Road bus stop nearest to our campus. A staff member will escort kids off the bus and to our facility. Parents with children attending other schools or are car riders, please drop your child off at the liberty bell entrance next to the sanctuary on the cemetery side. Please follow directional signs for Carmel Kids Academy. **All parents should pick up your child no later than 6:00pm on Wednesdays.**

Discipline Policy

We want everyone to have a good time during the programs we offer at Mount Carmel United Methodist Church.
